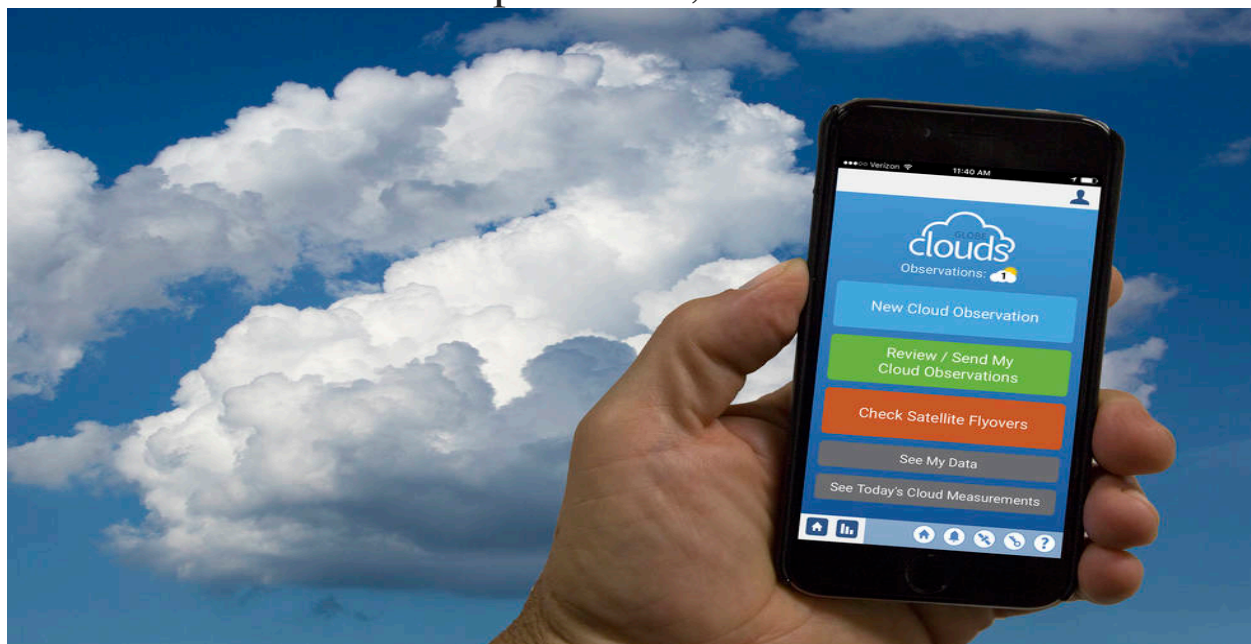

Become a GLOBE Observer using a NASA-developed app that allows citizen scientists to make cloud observations (data points on sky color, visibility, cloud properties and opacity, and surface conditions) that complement those from NASA satellites.

During this workshop, participants will:

- deploy the GLOBE Observer App in the field, collect and report data
- explore the connections between remotely sensed and ground validation data from NASA satellite missions
- dialogue and brainstorm with other educators on how citizen science data can be used in an informal science learning setting
- leave workshop with one or more GLOBE Observer data investigation activities suitable for your audiences
