

Scholarships available to Title 1 schools in Siletz Tribe service area for marine education programs at Hatfield Marine Science Center in Newport

Oregon Sea Grant Marine Education program received a grant from the Siletz Tribal Charitable Contribution Fund to provide scholarships for lab and field experiences at the Hatfield Marine Science Center.

To be eligible to apply a teacher must be from a Title 1 school in one of the following counties:

- Benton
- Clackamas
- Lane
- Lincoln
- Linn
- Marion
- Multnomah
- Polk
- Tillamook
- Washington
- Yamhill



Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, and can cover up to half of the program registration fee (maximum amount of \$150.00). Applicants will also need to submit a letter of justification.

If awarded, the scholarship funds will be applied directly to the online registration. After the trip you are required to send at least two high quality photos (that have the required photo permissions) of your students engaging in the program at Hatfield. Thank you letters to the Siletz Tribe recognizing their sponsorship are welcome.
