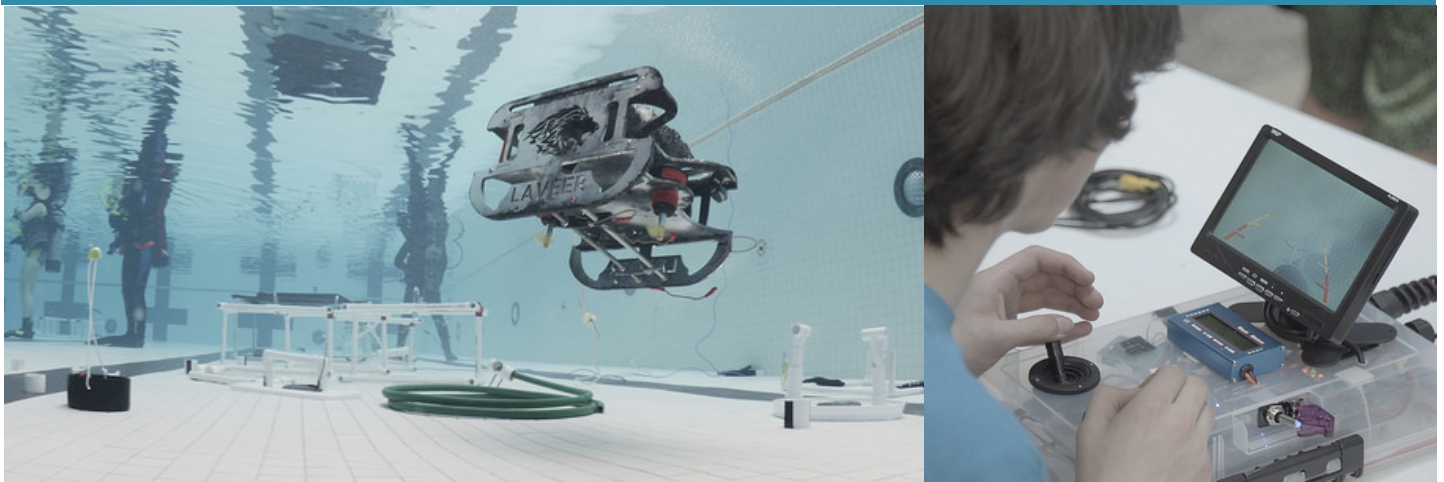




Introduction to ROVs Workshop
