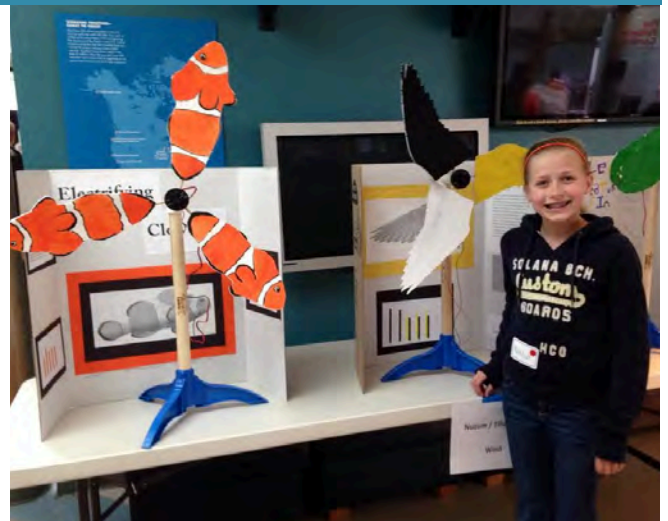
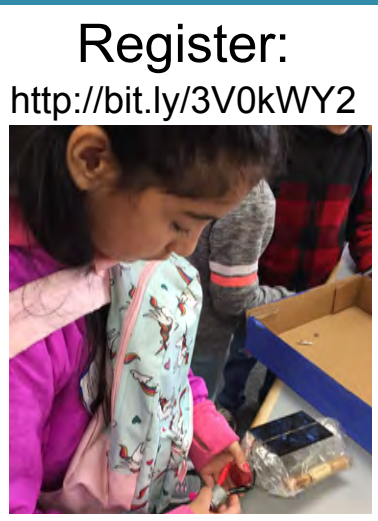




# Oregon Coast Renewable Energy Challenge

Students in grades 3-12 from Oregon coastal school districts are invited to bring their student-built wave energy, wind energy, and solar devices to Oregon State University's Hatfield Marine Science Center for this engaging competition event. Students will test their devices in wave tanks, wind tunnels, and solar tracks, and should bring a poster explaining their design process, how the device functions, and its potential benefits and impacts. Students will be interviewed by engineering judges, get a tour of the new HMSC Innovation Lab, and participate in presentations by OSU researchers and the Oregon Department of Energy.
