You're Invited | Represent your business and meet the more than 1,500 Lincoln County high school students who will attend our districtwide Career Fair on Wednesday, April 22, from 8:20 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the Main Gym at Taft 7-12 School in Lincoln City. There is no fee to reserve an information table.

This is an exciting opportunity for you to share the work experience, educational requirements, character attributes and other factors that you look for when interviewing and selecting candidates for professional, entry-level jobs. Students who are interested in pursuing careers in your industry will visit tables to ask you questions and learn more about your profession and career opportunities.

Reservation Deadline Is **April 10** | Your reservation includes use of one table and up to two chairs so that you'll have plenty of room to speak directly to students, display items relevant to your work if you like, and distribute brochures, flyers or other materials. You're encouraged to bring employment and recruiting materials, and table coverings. A limited number of outlets and extension cords may be available; indicate if you require special equipment in your reservation. Your reservation also includes free parking, and complimentary beverages, morning snack and burrito lunch.

- Name, job title, email address and phone number of the representative attending the LCSD Career Fair on April 22; and
- A brief description of your company's work, products or services.

Once I receive your reservation, you will be emailed a confirmation letter, event schedule, load-in/load-out instructions, campus map, and helpful hints to plan your tableside conversations with students.
