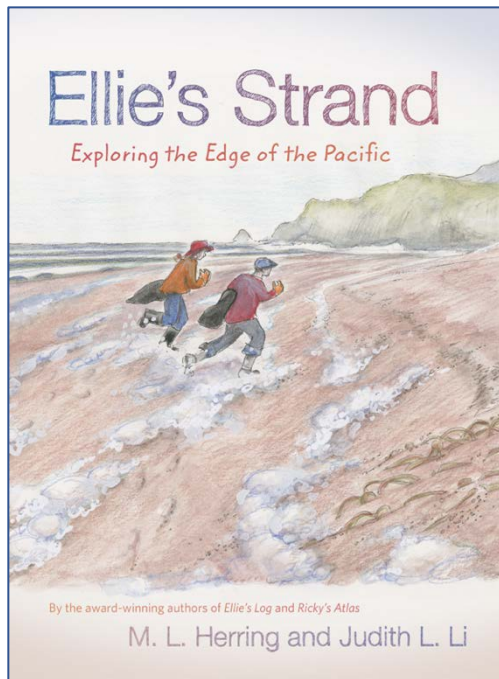




Discoveries at the Edge of the Pacific
